




OPTION 1: EXPLORING CLARKSVILLE - A DAY OF DELIGHTFUL DISCOVERIES




OPTION 2: HORSEHEAD LAKE ADVENTURE - NATURE'S CANVAS BECKONS

LOCATION: HORSEHEAD LAKE LODGE, 213 COUNTY ROAD 3190, CLARKSVILLE, AR 72830






OPTION 3: LAKE LUDWIG FISHING ADVENTURE - A DAY OF RELAXATION AND RECREATION

OPTION 1: THE GLORY HOLE ADVENTURE - NATURE'S MASTERPIECE UNVEILED

Spot the trailhead half a mile East of a red barn adorned with a prominent white "E" on the North side of the road. A large dirt/gravel area welcomes you for parking, marked by a sign that simply says "Glory Hole."

The Trail Unveiled:

Embark on a trail that initially follows an old road, leading to an intersection. Choose the road to the right, curving and descending through a picturesque, steep slope. As you traverse approximately a mile, find yourself atop Glory Hole Falls. Exercise caution around the rocks, and as you loop back, marvel at the falls from the base, where water gracefully pours through the captivating hole above.

Afternoon: Culinary Delights at Oark General Store

On your return to Clarksville, indulge in a delectable lunch at the historic Oark General Store. Dating back to 1890, this charming establishment promises not just a meal but a taste of tradition.

Evening: Hammocks and Sunset Serenity at Spadra Park
